On the Ardennes plateau, the founders have created the conditions for organising workshops, strategic days and development seminars for management and other groups.

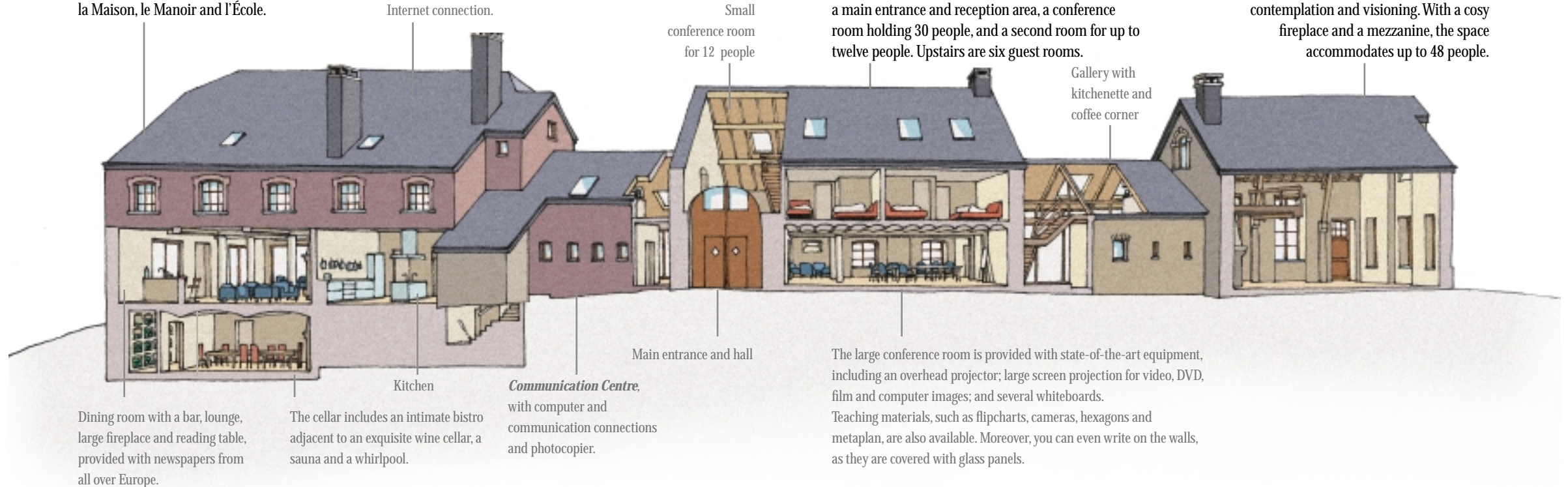
THREE INTERCONNECTED BUILDINGS

La Maison is a newly built space, as are the connecting structures between la Maison, le Manoir and l'École.

Upstairs are fifteen guest rooms, each with two beds, a shower, a desk and an Internet connection.

Le Manoir was a farmhouse for 50 years. The building has now been restored and consists of a main entrance and reception area, a conference room holding 30 people, and a second room for up to twelve people. Upstairs are six guest rooms.

l'École is a 150-year-old school, now converted into a place for lecturing, contemplation and visioning. With a cosy fireplace and a mezzanine, the space accommodates up to 48 people.



A pleasant 15-minute walk takes you from the Hubermont Centre down to the banks of the Ourthe River.

Nearby there are many sporting opportunities, including rock-climbing, rafting, canoeing, mountain biking, horseback riding, and fishing.

Additionally, there are three golf courses within 50 kilometres. During winter you can practice cross-country skiing. And any season will do for taking beautiful walks in the peaceful countryside.



WELCOME

HOLISTIC We offer two residence formulae. 'Holistic' stands for learning (work) and living as an integrated whole. This implies that the group itself runs the household. The participants take care of day-to-day living during the program. For preparing excellent meals professional kitchen materials are available.

EXCELLENCE Alternatively, you may opt for a complete hotel service including excellent cuisine prepared by our chef. Of course, intermediate, tailor-made arrangements are also possible.

PHYSICAL LAYOUT We have 20 bedrooms that can accommodate 40 people. Depending on the size of your group and your specific needs, you can occupy the whole centre or half of it. In the latter case, you will have 9 guest rooms (maximum 13), the use of one of the large conference rooms, the breakout facilities of the small conference room, the mezzanine, etc.

ARRIVING BY CAR

From Brussels

- Take E411 towards Luxembourg
- At Courriere take the N4 towards Marche-en-Famenne and Bastogne
- Exit La Roche (N888)
- In La Roche take the N834 towards Bastogne
- After 5 km you will see Hubermont on the left
- Drive straight ahead to the highest point in the village where you will find the Hubermont Centre

From Maastricht

- Take E25 towards Luxembourg
- Exit N° 50 Baraque de Fraiture
- Take N89 towards La Roche
- In La Roche take N834 towards Bastogne
- After 5 km you will see Hubermont on the left
- Drive straight ahead to the highest point in the village where you will find the Hubermont Centre

From Luxembourg or France

- Take E411 towards Brussels
- At l'Eglise take E25 towards Bastogne and Liege
- Exit N° 53 Hemroulle and turn right
- At the traffic light take N834 towards La Roche
- After 19 km you will see Hubermont on the right
- Drive straight ahead to the highest point in the village where you will find the Hubermont Centre

ARRIVING BY PLANE

- Brussels Airport is a drive of 1 hour 10 minutes
- Luxembourg Airport is a drive of 50 minutes
- Transport can be provided with or without a driver
